5. Describe the effects of wind, water, and ice on the landscape.
6. Draw a diagram showing different types of volcanoes or draw a diagram that labels the different parts of a volcano.
7. Make a power or display showing 10 every day products that contain or use minerals.
8. Draw the inside of a cave showing the difference between stalactites and stalagmites.
